COMPUTER SERVICES AND FACILITIES FOR EPSEVG STUDENTS

Access to computer facilities

Students have free access to any computer room providing there are no scheduled sessions. Room AI113 (first floor) are intended for free access.

Computer Accounts

Students have two user **accounts**, one for the Windows systems and the other for the Linux systems. Each one has its own storage space at the server (xoroi for windows and karaba for Linux), about 150MBytes, and its own password.

The **username** consists of 8 characters related to your ID card or passport number. The first character is a letter that comes from the translation of the first digit of the ID card/ Passport number as shown in this table:

0	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	[a-z]
a	b	c	d	e	f	g	h	i	j	x

The following characters are the seven remaining digits of the ID card / passport.

The initial **password** is the same in both operating systems.

Initial Password: *ddmmyyxx*

ddmmyy is the birth date

(dd - day, mm - month, yy - year)

xx are the last digits of the ID card or passport

Printing service

Students can print from computers, Windows or Linux, with the following limit:

Regular students: 20 sheets per month

Final degree project students and EPS students: 150 sheets per semester

Note for Linux users: after normal Linux login, a window will pop-up asking for the Windows user name and password in order to use the printer.

Scanner self-service

There is a PC available at the entrance to the Computer Department (STIC) with an scanner that any student can use.

Borrowing service

The Library has some laptops which can be lent to students. These computers have the same software as the ones in the computer rooms.

In the computer department (STIC) you can borrow computer equipment for educational purposes.

The student email account is in the format *firstname.lastname@estudiant.upc.edu* which can be accessed and managed from the web page:

username: *firstname.lastname*

password: *ddmmyyxx* (birth date with the last two digits of the ID / Passport number)

Digital Campus service: ATENEA

Atenea is an online site (aka “Virtual Campus” or “Digital Campus”), based on Moodle, where teachers publish materials and resources for the students who follow their courses.
